Medical nutrition therapy (MNT) is a key component of diabetes education and management. MNT is defined as a "nutrition-based treatment provided by a registered dietitian nutritionist.". It includes "a nutrition diagnosis as well as therapeutic and counseling services to help manage diabetes." 57. Studies have documented an association between MNT delivered by a registered dietitian and A1c decreases for people with type 1 diabetes (0.3%–1%) 58.

The American Diabetes Association (ADA) emphasizes that medical nutrition therapy (MNT) is fundamental in the overall diabetes management plan, and the need for MNT should be reassessed frequently by health care providers in collaboration with people with diabetes across the life span, with special attention during times of changing health status and life stages (1-3).

All individuals with prediabetes or diabetes should receive nutrition education that considers access to nutritious foods, as well as personal and cultural preferences.
