MLA format follows the author-page method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the page number(s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

MLA has rules for formatting your Word document. Your paper should have: Times New Roman font. 12 pt size. Double spacing. 1-inch margins. First line indent on each paragraph in the body of your paper. Hanging indent on each Works Cited citation. Your last name and page number at the top right of each page header.

MLA formatting shows itself as a convenient way of formatting research papers that allows the writer to write, but not to dwell too much on formatting. Starting with the absence of the title page and finishing with font types and margins, the writer appreciates the style he chooses. Get your paper written by a professional writer

An MLA style paper should fit certain standard layout guidelines. This section describes how to meet those guidelines. Set the font to 12-point Times New Roman. MS-Word documents often default to 10-point pitch.

Citation formatting in MLA style paper Even when you are working on a short essay (as opposed to say, a complex MLA style research paper), you will probably be giving references in your work. As in any other academic format, all direct citations presuppose giving reference to the original author's name.

MLA Style Paper: Flexible Guidelines vs. Specific Rules

In both APA and MLA style, you list full details of all cited sources on a separate page at the end of your paper. In APA this is usually called the reference list; in MLA it is called the works cited. The formatting of source entries is different in each style.
